Objectives

- Understand what social entrepreneurship is and its relation to sustainable development.
- Explore different social enterprise approaches and identify different models through showcasing and local study visits.
- Learn about the social impact of social enterprises.
- Create a social enterprise business plan.
- Explore Erasmus+ for entrepreneurial education and source of social enterprises starting point.
- Acquire practical tools for social entrepreneurs (needs analysis using the 'problem tree method', business plan development through the 'business model canvas', pitching tools.
- Develop competencies, necessary for social entrepreneurs, such as cooperation, risk taking, sense of initiative, leadership, communication, teamwork, creative thinking and innovation for idea generation and problem solving.

The methodology used will be based on principles of non-formal and experiential learning with an emphasis on the experiential learning cycle of Kolb. Participants will be invited to a safe and comfortable space to express, experiment, interact and participate



according to their personality and learning preference. In this way, we seek to maximize the learning outcomes but also the motivation and inspiration to engage with social and solidarity economy.

Working Methods: The training is based on methods specific to non-formal education and includes:

- team building activities,
- conceptual delimitation,
- practical applications on Canvas model for social enterprises,
- exchanging good practices,
- development of organizational capacity,
- intercultural activities.

Venue: Sivas, Türkiye

Sivas located on the east part of Central Anatolia and on the interchanges of ancient Silk Road as well as the famous king's roads interchanges passes through the city. Talaur, Sebaste, Danisment, Sibas, Eyalet-i Rum, Megapolis, Eyalet-i Sivas, Kabira and Diaspolis (the city of the god) are some of the names which were given by the kingdoms, and empires those ruled over the city in the history.



The area was an important historical and cultural center as it's the place where the first settlements of Turkish Republic was found and the birth place of great poet Asik Veysel. Having a great value of natural wonders and beauties with it's forest, mountains, streaming waters, rivers, lakes and caves is one of the most popular city for providing available racecourses and opportunities for many type of sports, activities and tours such as caravan – camping, hunting, mountaineering, trekking, sportive fishing and rafting. The world wide famous Turkish Shepherd Dog (Kangal Kopegi) is famous highlight of the area especially in Kangal Town of Sivas. Anatolia M.d. By establishing a political union of lü in 1800, the first settlement areas of the Hittite empire in the past in Sivas, Phrygians, Lydians, Roman and Byzantine domination of people, "Diapolls" and "Sebaste" was also named as.
