 - Correct misconceptions about blood donation and provide accurate information about blood diseases among young people.
- · Develop Blood Donation Habits:
 - Encourage regular blood donation habits among young people.
 - Promote the adoption of blood donation as a sustainable community service and emphasize its significance in the fight against blood diseases.
- Raise Awareness of Blood Diseases:
 - Provide accurate information about blood diseases within the community.
 - Increase awareness among young people about the causes, symptoms, and treatment methods
 of blood diseases.
- · Enhance Community Participation:
 - Ensure active participation of young people and community members in activities related to blood donation and blood diseases.
 - Collaborate with public and private sector organizations to increase community involvement.

Objective of the Project

- Diversity and Equality:
 - Promote diversity in accessing information about blood donation and blood diseases.
 - · Ensure that young leaders involved in the project represent diverse communities.
- · Media and Communication Strategies:
 - Develop an effective communication strategy on blood donation and blood diseases among young people through social media, press, and other communication channels.
 - Collaborate with media partners to increase the visibility of the project.
- Education and Information Activities:
 - Conduct seminars, workshops, and information sessions to enhance the knowledge of young people about blood donation and blood diseases.
 - · Collaborate with healthcare professionals to ensure the dissemination of accurate information.
- Sustainability and Continuity:
 - Ensure that awareness about blood donation and blood diseases continues in the community after the project concludes.
 - Support young leaders involved in the project to lead sustainable initiatives in their communities.

You can only use public transportation.

In order for payments to be processed quickly, accurately, and without any issues, the suitability of your travel documents is crucial. Reviewing documents that do not meet the following criteria may take time, resulting in delays in payments and the need for bank transfers. Any transfer fees associated with bank transfers will be borne by the participant. The document should contain the following information:

- 1. Passenger's Name (As it is written in passport)
- 2. Route Invoice or ticket date
- 3. Ticket details
- 4. Amount (preferably in Euros)

The following documents will not be accepted:

- 1.Bank or credit card statements
- 2. Monthly, weekly, or daily public transportation tickets
- 3. Taxi receipts
- 4. Documents related to travel outside the accepted route
- 5. Documents related to travel not approved by the organizing institution
- 6.Irregular, torn, worn-out, or illegible documents

Travel-related documents will be collected on March 12-13. The participant should prepare the following documents:

- 1. Passport
- 2. Boarding pass
- 3. Tickets
- 4. Entry stamp to the country (for those using a travel document other than a passport)
 Please ensure that your travel documents meet the specified criteria to avoid any delays in payment processing.



If the participant requests payment for the return journey tickets to be made after the activities at the venue, the full payment for the travel expenses will be made to the participant via bank transfer ONLY AFTER the necessary documents have been submitted to the organizing institution in the appropriate manner. Any expenses related to this transfer will be borne by the participant.
